INGREDIENTS

Soybean Meal, Corn Distillers Dried Grains w/ Solubles, Alfalfa Meal, Wheat Middlings, Corn, Cane Molasses, Calcium Carbonate, Lignin Sulfonate, Vitamin A Acetate in Gelatin, Vitamin D-3 Supplement, Vitamin E Supplement, Vitamin B-12 Supplement, Menadione Sodium Bisulfate Complex, Riboflavin Supplement, d-Calcium Pantothenate, Niacin, Thiamine Mononitrate, d-Calcium Pantothenate, Niacin Supplement, Choline Chloride, Zinc Sulfate, Ferrous Sulfate, Manganese Sulfate, Sodium Molybdate, Ethylenediamine Dihydriodide, Cobalt Sulfate, and Sodium Selenite.

FEEDING DIRECTIONS

Feed free choice up to 1 lb of feed per head, per day, to nursing lambs. Feeders should allow lambs to enter, but ewes are to be kept out.

Feed with good quality hay and fresh water, free choice.
Store feed in a cool dry place.
